Registration/Orientation:

Students may call Kelly at 435-2474 Ext. 108 to request an application. Once the application is completed and returned, and a TABE test has been Taken, students will be notified when space becomes available in class. An orientation session at Literacy Green Bay must be attended prior to enrollment in the program.

Eligibility:

Students are required to complete a TABE survey in reading and language at Literacy Green Bay as part of the application process. Based on the results of this test, students will either be eligible to enroll in GED programming or referred for one-on-one tutoring to increase their skill level.

Cost:

\$20 Registration Fee (one time only fee, as long as the student remains active)
Fee is due at time of registration

Childcare:

Early Childhood Education is provided for **children of students only** who are between the ages of 1 year and 8 years only. Childcare space is limited at times.
